

An upgraded aluminum water outlet for Toyota and Lexus vehicles to replace the OE plastic that is prone to warping and premature failures.

A reengineered thermostat housing assembly for certain Dodge, Jeep, Chrysler, Ram and VW vehicles made from corrosion-resistant aluminum. This replaces the plastic OE housing that becomes brittle over time. It also decreases the changes of cracks from overtightening the bleeder valve.





Dorman has engineered a fuel pump cam follower to match the fit, function and performance of the original equipment cam follower. It is designed to replace a worn original equipment cam follower and help restore proper fuel pressure.
