MAHLE Aftermarket Hosting Training Seminars

At the recently held PRI Show MAHLE focused on ways to enhance vehicle engine performance during two training seminars featuring Dan Begle, MAHLE's Technical Sales Engineer.

The first was held at the Engine Professional Industry Conference (EPIC), hosted by the AERA Engine Builders Association, on Wednesday, December 6th. The EPIC



presentation explored the technical operation of engine bearings including wear indicators and how common failures happen. Although the primary focus was on engine bearings, additional topics on other engine components were discussed.

2022 Keynote Update

I recently spent some time in Washington, DC and had the privilege of attending a promotion and swearing-in ceremony for my nephew. If you were at the 2022 convention in Greenville, then Sergeant Major of the Marine

Corps Troy E. Black spoke to us about leadership, setting goals and the importance of training. Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps Black was supposed to retire in August, 2023 but the military had other plans for him. He has been appointed as the 5th Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Joint Chief of Staff (SEAC) making him the most senior enlisted person in all the military. He will work directly for Joint Chief of Staff General Brown in the Pentagon.



SEAC Black has deployed 14 times throughout the world including twice each to Iraq and Afghanistan since he joined the Marine Corps in April of 1998. He is the first SEAC to serve coming out of a combat billet. Previous SEAC's have come from the admin side.

Throughout his career he as been assigned numerous duties: including 0331 Machine Gunner, Machine Gun Squad and Section Leader; Weapons Platoon Sergeant and Weapons Platoon Commander; Drill Instructor; Senior Drill Instructor; Fleet Anti-Terrorism Security Team Company (FAST) Platoon Sergeant and Operations Chief, Series Gunnery Sergeant; DI School Instructor and RTR Drill Master; First Sergeant, G Company 2nd Bn, 1st Marines, E Company 3d Amphibious Assault Battalion, Officer Candidates School; Sergeant Major, 3d Bn, 7th Marines, Combat Logistics Battalion 5, 11th Marine Expeditionay Unit, 1st Marine Logistics Group, and Manpower and Reserve Affairs. Not to be left out, he served as the 19th Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps from 2019 to 2023. His personal awards include the Navy Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit with 2 Gold Stars, Bronze Star with Combat Distinguishing Devise, Meritorious Service Medal with 2 Gold Stars, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal with Combat Distinguishing Device and 3 Gold Stars, Navy and Marine Corp Achievement Medal with Gold Star and the Combat Action Ribbon with 2 Gold Stars.

SEAC Black has a Bachelor of Science in Terrorism and Counter-Terrrorism Studies from National American University and graduated from the Joint Special Operations Forces Senior Enlisted Academy in December of 2011.
